Sally Ride

June 18, 1983, is an important day for both space travel and women. It was on this day in 1983 that Sally Ride became the first American woman astronaut to go into outer space.

Sally Ride was born on May 26, 1951, in California. She worked hard in school and in sports.

In college, she studied science and became interested in working as an astronaut. She was hired by NASA in 1977 and, two years later, was ready to become an astronaut.

Finally, in 1983, she was able to go into outer space! This was the trip she wanted her whole life! A few years later in 1986, she was supposed to go into space again with a team of other astronauts. They were going to travel on a space shuttle called the "Challenger" but it had an accident during a different mission and exploded so Sally's trip was cancelled.

Sally Ride kept working as an astronaut until 1987 when she retired which means she stopped working at her job. Then, she started teaching. She wanted to teach girls the importance of math and science like she loved so much!

In 2003, Sally received an award and her name was placed into the Astronaut Hall of Fame. The Astronaut Hall of Fame honors astronauts for their hard work in spaceflight.
