### Chocolate Chip Cook Factor: Place Value (free)



As the owner of the chocolate chip factor, students are to deliver the cookie count matches on the cookie order. The cookies are sold by ones, packages that contain tens, and boxes have one hundred cookies. Students are to tap on the cookies as quickly as they can to deliver the placement of the cookie order!

## Place Value MAB Addition



It gives a 2-digit addition problem and has the child touch and drag the place value blocks to represent the numbers. When they put ten ones in the basket, they can click "Make" and it will make a ten. They have to figure out the answer and input the value.

#### Brainnook Arithmetic (free)



This app allows students to practice addition and subtraction. It also provides students with number placement for place value.

#### Mystery Number



Students have the opportunity to practice the one hundred chart and see mathematical patterns. Students explore how to add/subtract by ten, and by ones. This app also offers a number line so that students build math knowledge using various mathematical presentations.

# Number Pieces Basic (free)



This is basically just like a work mat for working with any kind of place value problems. Students can show various amounts with the hundreds, tens, and ones. There's a pen tool so they can write numbers, number sentences, etc. They can also circle groups of ten ones with the pen to show that they are switching it for a ten.
