## ELA/Writing

This month we will be reading *The Dog That Dug for Dinosaurs, Yeh-Shen, Two of Everything, and Now & Ben* in our Anthology We will be working on the following comprehension strategies: Fact and Opinion, Questioning, Sequencing of Events, Analyzing/Evaluating, Understanding Characters, Summarizing, Compare and Contrast and Visualizing. In grammar, we will cover adverbs, possessive nouns, and adjectives.

Also, we will start our unit Fictional Narratives. Students will focus on developing characters, setting, events, problem and solution. They will utilize descriptive language and the use of dialogue throughout their writing.

## Math

In Unit 8, students will explore 2- and 3dimensional shapes and their attributes. They will partition rectangles into rows and columns of same-size squares. Also, they will explore strategies for determining the total number of objects in equal groups and rectangular arrays.
